1. **Team rosters must have a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 7 players. At least one player must be a current student at LCCS.** LCCS students are encouraged to invite friends from their neighborhood, church, etc. to join your team.
2. Tournament is co-ed. Games start with 6 players. Teams can be all boys or all girls. .
3. For the high school tournament, teams may include 1 adult provided the adult is a teacher or youth leader from a school or church.
4. Players must dress so that it is clear which team they belong to. That can be players wearing the same color shirt, but it can also be dressed to a particular theme.
5. **Cost is \$5 per player; 6 player team = \$30, 7 player team = \$35.** Checks made payable to "LCCS." Payment must be included with the team registration.
6. Middle School is open to students grades 6-8. High school is open to grades 9-12.
7. Registration forms with payment are to be turned in to the school office or mailed to: Lake Center Christian School, 12893 Kaufman Ave. NW, Hartsville, OH 44632. **Deadline to submit a team registration with payment is Tuesday, April 10.**
8. All players must have a permission slip turned in before being allowed to play. Permission slips can be turned in during check-in on the day of the tournament.

Teams

1. Team rosters must have a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 7 players. Games start with 6 players.
2. High school teams may have 1 adult on their team provided the adult is a teacher or youth leader from a school or church.

Schedule

1. Middle school teams must report in between 3:45-4:15. Rules meeting for all players will be at 4:20. Tournament runs from 4:30-6:30 p.m.
2. High school teams must report in between 6:15-6:45. Rules meeting for all players will be at 6:50. Tournament runs from 7:00-9:00 p.m.

The Court

Contests will be played in the gymnasium, which will be split into two courts with a curtain dividing the courts. Out-of-bounds lines will be clearly marked and pointed out to players. Championship matches will be changed to the varsity basketball court.

The Equipment

The official ball used in the tournament will be a 6-inch rubber-coated foam ball.

The Game

The object of the game is to eliminate all opposing players by getting them "OUT". This may be done by:

1. Hitting an opposing player with a thrown ball.
 - a. A player is considered hit if any part of his body, hair or clothing is touched by the thrown ball.
 - b. A ball thrown that hits an opponent and then hits another opponent eliminates both opponents.
2. Catching a ball thrown by your opponent before it touches the ground, back wall, side wall or side curtain. (If a player catches a ball that was deflected off of a teammate, neither the teammate nor the opponent who threw the ball is out.)
3. Causing an opponent to drop a ball as a result of contact by another thrown live ball. (This usually occurs when a ball is being used as a shield to block a thrown ball.)
4. An opposing player steps out of bounds. (Exception: players may step out of bounds – not into their opponent's space – to retrieve a ball. Players have 5 seconds to return to the court with the ball.)
5. If, during the contest, team A has more players than team B, and all balls are on the side of team A, then team A has 10 seconds to throw a ball or a player will be eliminated.
6. Any player sliding for a ball at the start of the contest.

Other Rules

1. A ball is live once it is thrown at an opponent. A live ball becomes dead once it hits any wall or side curtain, the floor, or the ceiling. A ball laying on the floor shall be considered part of the floor. When the time limit expires all balls are dead, even if they are in the air when the horn blows.
2. Contests will be started when all players are touching the back wall and all balls are placed on the center court line. A whistle will be blown. Players race to the center to get a ball. Sliding IS NOT permitted. Before a ball can become live at the start, it must be taken back to the back wall.
3. The contest is over when all players from one team have been eliminated.
4. All contests will have a 4 minute time limit. If no team has been entirely eliminated within 4 minutes, the team with the most players is declared the winner. If both teams have the same number of players the contest a) is a draw during the round robin; b) restarted with all players, 1 minute on the clock, and the first team to knock out two opponents wins.

5. There are no time-outs.
6. There are no substitutions once a contest has begun.
7. All players must be wearing shoes, shorts or pants, and a shirt of matching color or theme with their teammates. Jewelry is worn at your own risk. Hats, headbands, knee pads, etc. are all permissible. All clothing should be modest and follow school dress code for athletic events.
8. All decisions by judges are final. There are no appeals. There are no instant replays.
9. Any player displaying poor sportsmanship, taunting, using profanity, etc. will be judged out of the contest. Judges and school officials may eject anyone for severe inappropriate behavior from the tournament and/or the school grounds. This is to be a fun time for everyone.
10. Contests last a maximum of 4 minutes. There is 2 minutes between games. Teams with less than 4 players when the contest begins will forfeit the contest. Teams must pay attention to the schedule and know when they are scheduled to play.
11. Scoring Contests during Round Robin: Eliminating a team within the 4 minutes scores 5 points. Winning by forfeiture or by having more players than your opponent, provided you eliminated at least 2 opponents, scores 4 points. A draw scores 2 points for each team. A loss scores 1 point. Losing by forfeiture scores 0 points.

Round Robin

A maximum of 16 teams will be entered. All teams will play a minimum of 3 contests. All teams will be assigned their spot on the schedule by a random drawing.

Playoffs

Following the round robin teams will be seeded for the playoffs which are single elimination. At least eight teams will advance to the playoffs.

Playoff contests will be the same as during the round robin, except the time limit will be 3 minutes and there cannot be a draw. Winners advance while the losing team is eliminated.

Team Theme

Prizes will be awarded to the team that shows the most team spirit. Teams are encouraged to be creative and have fun with their team appearance. We simply need to be able to distinguish one team from another during the contest.

Audience

Those who do not wish to play but want to watch are encouraged to attend and cheer for their favorite team. Admission is \$2. Seating will be available on the mezzanine. Spectators must watch for balls flying into seating area.
